- Gown measuring and payment for gowns and stoles.
- Reserved seating for families in alphabetical order
- Snacks – non- staining snacks available in dining room prior to 1:30 worship service

Confirmation Gowns, Stoles, and Luther Rose Pin

- Cost of **gown and stole is \$22.00** make checks payable to Glenwood Lutheran
- If you have a gown and only need the stole, the cost is **\$7.00**
- You may use a robe from a sibling or friend if it is from the same company (Oak Hall Gowns) we order from. Make sure it fits and is not stained.
- Gowns & stoles should be picked up at the church by **Wednesday, September 6**
- The gowns will need pressing/steaming, or, the gown company suggests hanging them in your bathroom for a few days during showers and baths to get out the wrinkles
- Luther Rose pins will be provided for each student on the day of Confirmation
- The gowns, stoles and pins are yours to keep.

Confirmation Day - Sunday, October 1

- Be at the church by **12 noon, put on gowns, stoles and pins**
- Photos are at **12:15pm**. Short rehearsal after photos
- Worship Service at **1:30pm**
- Lite Reception in dining room at **2:30pm**. This reception is open to all. You may use it as your reception or you may choose to have a reception at your home.

Confirmation Photos

- Each student will receive a free 5X7 group photo
- Individual photos will be according to the order you place.
- We are planning to have Teresa Peper as our photographer.
- **The price and photo information will be available when you pick up your robe.**

Faith Statement/Project

- **Due Wednesday, September 6**
- The theme will be “What My Faith in Christ Means to Me.”
- If you choose to write a paper it will be at least 5 paragraphs long – intro, paragraph, paragraph, paragraph, conclusion
- You may do an art project, photos, poem or song, carving, power point, or take a leadership role in a worship service, read scripture a couple of times, help with Day Camp, help with GLC Garden, run sound, run visuals, usher, etc

Personal Bible Verse

- Choose one verse from the Bible as your personal verse for Confirmation Day
- Keep it short such as Psalm 23 “The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.”
- **DO NOT USE** John 11:35 “Jesus Wept”
- Do not worry about having it memorized. Write it down and bring it with you when you come to the Altar.
