Greetings as we prepare for our Annual Congregation Meeting on Sunday, May 19th!

Remember this year we will have only one worship service at 10:30am that day, and the meeting will begin promptly after the worship service ends. But it doesn't stop there: AFTER the meeting is adjourned, we need people to help our Lead Custodian Paul Anderson move ALL our pews to carpeted areas so that a professional floor refinisher can work on our wood sanctuary floors. This will be completed before the following weekend worship service (Memorial Day Weekend), so they can be replaced.

At our Annual Meeting there will be three main items to deal with: passage of a 2024-2025 ministry budget, voting on amendments and changes to our constitution and bylaws, and elections. These three items should keep us busy (as if moving all the pews is not enough!).

In preparation for the Annual meeting there will be two information meetings held between worship services on Sunday, May 5 and 12. The May 5 meeting will focus on recommended changes to our church constitution. These are lengthy, and a copy of the recommended changes can be picked up on the desk in front of the church office. The May 12 meeting will focus on the proposed budget by the Board of Trustees; as this is still being finished, copies will be available at the meeting. In addition, a preliminary Congregational Annual Report will be available on May 5th, using information which has been submitted to the church office by the May 1 deadline.

Finally, and unrelated, I am looking forward to being absent from you on Memorial Day Weekend in order to celebrate the wedding of our daughter Britta Kristina Manning to Samuel Gates at The Hilltop House in Rochester. We are so excited for them! If you know our families, weddings are no small matter of joy and fun, and we are looking forward to this special time together with them. Pastor M

- **C10.03.** Notice of all meetings of this congregation shall be given at the services of worship on the preceding two consecutive Sundays and by mail or electronic means, as permitted by state law, to all voting members at least 10 days in advance of the date of the meeting.
- **C10.04.** 3 percent of the voting members shall constitute a quorum.
- **C10.05.** Voting by proxy or by absentee ballot shall not be permitted.
- **C10.06.** All actions approved by this congregation shall be by majority vote of those voting members present and voting, except as otherwise provided in this constitution or by state law.
- **C10.07.** Robert's Rules of Order, latest edition, shall govern parliamentary procedure of all meetings of this congregation.
- **C10.08.** This congregation may hold meetings by remote communication, including electronically and by telephone conference, as long as there is an opportunity for simultaneous aural communication or its equivalent. To the extent permitted by state law, notice of all meetings may be provided electronically.
- **C10.09.** "Ex officio" as used herein means membership with full rights of voice and vote unless otherwise expressly limited.
